PLEASURE FAIR had the best speed, set all the pace to the second turn, met bids from SLEWS IN DEMAND and I FOOLED YOU to the stretch then was under steady urging to hold. VENCEDORA AMIGA was allowed to settle three wide to the half, came two wide to the stretch then finished willingly inside through the drive. SHOW ME YOUR GLORY broke open his stall in the gate prior to the start then was away a bit awkwardly, had no speed, advanced inside on the second turn, closed confidently to mid stretch then could not sustain the needed rally and was overtaken for the place very late. BLUE IMP was unhurried to the half, commenced a bid into the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch, continued to rally to mid stretch then lost her punch. SLEWS IN DEMAND pressed the pace outside the winner to the second turn, made a run to the stretch then gave way in the drive. BILLIARD (GB) checked between rivals into the first turn, settled off the pace to the half, saved ground to the stretch then came up empty in the drive. I FOOLED YOU was also a pace factor three wide to the second turn then gave out after six furlongs. ISSUES STORM was not a factor and stopped in the stretch.
