HIDE THE SILVER was quickly in front to set all of the pace unchallenged, responded in the upper stretch to take a commanding lead then was eased up in the final sixteenth. ISIT CLASS chased the winner throughout, closed a gap late but was never a serious factor. MIDNIGHT MANGO steadied early from the rail, remained inside on the turn, the rider dropped his whip inside the eighth pole, but she came on gamely late. STORM KISU lagged early, came through inside on the turn and finished in a rally. CUZ YOU NEVER KNOW settled early, raced three wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. MY FIRST LADY raced wide and failed to rally.
