Footnotes

SWEET BOLD NRED broke alertly and dueled for command from the outset, edged clear briefly near the furlong pole but was kept to her task to hold. TYCHONICS MISTRESS was never too far back, rallied four wide into the lane, loomed a bold factor in mid stretch but could not get by the winner. MISS REIKO was void of any early speed and dropped to the rail, rallied into the stretch, was forced to check at the sixteenth pole, cut back to the rail and continued to close. RIVER STARLET broke alertly then was squeezed off at the start and raced unhurried, came two wide to the stretch and finished in a mild rally. ALPINE CREEK stalked the pace three wide but lacked the needed response. MISS SHAWNIE settled early, raced four wide on the turn but did not rally. FASHIONABLY LITE dueled into the stretch and weakened. COMPARISON broke poorly, lagged far back and closed too late. SMOKING MEMO settled early, tried to rally five wide on the turn then came up empty. CIMARRON HILLS was never a serious factor. SLIGHTLY SNOWBOUND saved ground to no avail.
