NINETENTHSOFTHELAW was quickly clear leaving the chute, set all the pace, pulled clear to the stretch then was under steady urging to the line. FANCY M. D. hopped at the start and had no speed, commenced a bid into the turn but was forced to circle five wide to the stretch then could not threaten the winner but was the best of the rest. GOTTA GO TO WORK was allowed to settle to the turn, got fanned four wide while trying to rally to the stretch then flattened out in the drive. NORTHERN GAME prompted the pace to the turn, steadied from between horses at the three eighths, dropped back to last and lost any chance. OUR MAGISTRATE chased the pace and was two wide to the stretch but had little to offer in the drive. BIG LEAGUE also stalked the pace to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but gave out in the drive. A steward's inquiry into the trouble that NORTHERN GAME encountered into the turn found that NORTHERN GAME was in tight but took back on his own and no fault was found therefore no change was made.
