Footnotes

CLASSIELYTE was used a bit at the start to track MR ALL IN from the rail, remained inside and directly behind that rival on the turn then was boxed in the upper stretch, checked near the furlong pole, maneuvered outside DAY OF THE SOUTH to lose a bit of momentum, but dug in gamely in the final sixteenth to offer an impressive rally and won going away. GRIFFINSTOWN raced unhurried to the turn, advanced inside to the stretch, shifted out at the three sixteenths and closed willingly. MR. ALL IN set all of the pace from just off the rail, dropped to the rail once in the stretch, led to the deep stretch but slackened late. FOLLOWS NONE lagged to the turn, came three wide to the stretch and finished well from the extreme outside. DAY OF THE SOUTH pressed MR ALL IN from the outside to mid stretch and slackened. MAEKEN NOISE was permitted to settle early, offered a menacing rally three wide on the turn but flattened out in the drive.
