### Footnotes

NINEBANKS broke cleanly and tracked the pace from the rail from the outset, waited patiently on the second turn then got through inside I'MADRIFTER to gain command in the upper stretch while coming off the rail, responded gamely and held off NICOBAR in the finals strides. NICOBAR (GB) raced unhurried early but always within striking distance, saved ground on the second turn and followed the winner into the stretch, got up inside that rival in mid stretch to challenge for command but could not get by. NATIONAL ANTHEM (GB) was permitted to lag to the second turn then offered a steady rally from the inside and was gaining at the wire. LADIES DIN was not asked for speed early while just off the rail, eased to the outside for the second turn, offered a menacing bid while circling rivals five wide to the stretch, loomed a bold factor in mid stretch but flattened out late. BIT OF LUCK (GB) prompted the pace from the outset, offered his best bid three wide at the quarter pole and slackened in the lane. SURPRISE HALO was permitted to settle early while three wide, was fanned four wide and between horses on the second turn while offering his bid then lost much of his punch in the final furlong. WOLFWITHINTEGRITY was well placed early from off the rail but failed to respond in the lane. I'MADRIFTER set the pace from off the rail for six furlongs and gave out.
