REDATTORE (BRZ) broke alertly and raced up outside to track KERRYGOLD (FR) on the lead, was content to follow that rival to the second turn, responded when called upon into the stretch to wrest command, ducked in at the furlong pole while drawing clear and held driving. HAWKSLEY HILL (IRE) raced unhurried early just off the rail, remained under patient handling to the second turn, commenced his bid three wide into the stretch and was gaining late. KERRYGOLD (FR) bumped with KAIBO (GB) at the start but quickly recovered to take a clear lead into the first turn, continued to set the pace on the backstretch from well off the rail, dropped inside on the second turn, met the winner's bid into the stretch then could not match strides, checked off the winner at the furlong pole and slackened. IRISH PRIZE settled from the rail into the first turn, tried to rally while two wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response. ENTORCHADO (IRE) lagged early from the outside, remained out on the second turn to be four wide to the stretch closed a mild gap but failed to be a serious contender. KAIBO (GB) was bumped at the start by KERRYGOLD then settled from the rail, remained inside on the second turn while offering a brief bid into the stretch then flattened out. BING BANG (FR) trailed to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and was never a serious factor. EAGLETON broke alertly then fell back, saved ground on the second turn and finished in a mild rally. FIGHTING FALCON was well placed from the outset, raced three wide throughout and did not respond.
