Footnotes

HEAVENLY MEETING broke cleanly but was not asked for speed while two wide to the backstretch, advanced inside on the second turn to reach serious contention at the head of the lane, angled between the two pacesetters leaving the furlong pole, got to terms with DIXIE ROCKER in the final stages and just did take a head bob decision. DIXIE ROCKER (NZ) dueled inside HURRICANE ROSE to the stretch, gradually disposed of that one but was quickly met by the winner and gave way grudgingly. HURRICANE ROSE prompted the pace two wide into the stretch and slackened in mid stretch. BLUE IMP stalked the leaders from the rail to the second turn, eased three wide to loom a bold factor into the lane but lacked the needed response. RIVER ELLA raced unhurried from the outside to the half mile pole, continued off the rail on the second turn and finished in a late rally only. TRUKNDOWNTHEAVENUE tracked the leaders from the outside to the second turn, then failed to respond while four wide nearing the quarter pole. DARLIN COREY lacked good early speed or the needed rally. PLAYGIRL saved ground to little avail. CYCLE OF LIFE was never a factor.
