HIGH BARBAREE was in stride quickly and set all of the pace from just off the rail, responded in the upper stretch and held driving. HIT THE ROAD broke alertly then took back just off the leader, advanced three wide on the turn to loom a factor in the upper stretch but lacked further response. THE PARTIES OVER raced unhurried early, came four wide to the stretch and closed willingly from well back. SAVAGE SAGE was permitted to settle early, offered a brief bid four wide on the turn but had nothing left for the drive. IMAGRY showed little. THE KIND YOU NEED prompted the winner from the rail to the head of the lane and stopped. PLAY RHYTHM had no speed.
