ADREAMISBORN was unhurried for a half, responded when asked into the second turn, came two wide then swung out into the stretch, found another gear in mid stretch and exploded to win going away. TRUE DANCER was allowed to settle for a half, was asked for speed into the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then wore down SANGER for the place without threatening the winner. SANGER sped clear and widened to the half, responded when the field took closer order to the second turn, remained clear to mid stretch then tired. MARSHALL ROOSTER (GB) saved ground while also in no hurry, was inside while attempting to rally on the second turn, had to check in traffic on the rail nearing the quarter pole, responded once clear and closed willingly to the line. JUNIPER KRIS chased the leader to the half, made a bid into the second turn but came up empty in the drive. MOTEL STAFF was also chasing two wide, closed the gap to the second turn, was a factor to the stretch but weakened in the drive. SURPRISE HALO raced three wide to the backstretch and settled to the half, was asked for speed while three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. BRING HOME THEGOLD was outrun throughout.
