Footnotes

NUMEROUS XS was never too far back while racing three wide to the backstretch, remained out on the second turn to circle the leaders three wide, rallied steadily and was up in the final strides. SLEW A SOLDIER was permitted to settle early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn, shifted out for the drive then closed with a bold rush and just missed from between the top two. ALWAYS THE BEST was hustled to the lead in the opening stages to set all of the pace, came off the rail once in the stretch and gave way grudgingly. SOCIAL SLEWPYP was not asked for speed early, raced two wide into the lane then closed best through traffic to just miss. VIA TAHOE stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, was blocked behind the leaders into the lane, dropped inside to offer his bid but flattened out late. LOUIE'S RUBIES was permitted to settle early and raced unhurried, was two wide on the second turn, rallied behind traffic in the stretch then was blocked nearing the wire and raced in check. STORM ADVISORY prompted the pace two wide to the stretch and slackened. FACE THE MUSIC broke inward and slow then lagged, raced three wide throughout and lacked the needed response. REGALESQUE was void of any speed to the stretch then found his best stride too late. JUST L stalked the pace four wide for a half mile and came up empty.
