GOOD THOUGHTS broke in stride and set all of the pace from the inside, turned back bids at the quarter pole then responded in the stretch and edged clear. MOON WOMAN pressed the winner from the outset, had her best bid between horses at the quarter pole, could not go with the winner in the lane but outfinished DOTSY JEAN for the place. DOTSY JEAN was never far back, moved up to challenge three wide on the turn and flattened out in the drive. CHERRY COSMO was well placed from the rail to the stretch but lacked the needed response. SHEEN FALLS steadied from between horses shortly after the start to fall back, raced four wide on the turn and failed to rally. CHROMETICS broke alertly but fell back early and was not a factor.
