Footnotes

IVORY QUEEN took back off the pace to settle from the rail into the first turn, advanced from just off the rail on the second turn to be directly behind the leaders, awaited room inside into the stretch, found an opening once straightened for the drive, offered her bid from the rail at the furlong pole, gained command in mid stretch and held in a grueling stretch battle. SUSANNE (GB) was never too far back, came three wide to the stretch, challenged in the upper stretch but was outfinished by the top two. BATES OF COURSE trailed to the 2nd turn, was sent up four wide to the stretch and finished steadily from the extreme outside. WOLFNIK took back from between the leaders into the backstretch then settled, tracked the pace to the second turn, came two wide into the stretch to be challenging at the three sixteenths pole and gave way grudgingly. MAURICIENNE (FR) raced up three wide on the first turn to take command once on the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn while maintaining the advantage, drifted off the rail into the lane and slackened late. CUZ YOU NEVER KNOW set the early pace, stopped into the second turn and was eased.
