Footnotes

NO PESO NO DANCE broke alertly and tracked the pace from the outset, commenced her bid three wide into the lane, collared DARLING KRIS in mid stretch and pulled clear driving. DARLING KRIS was never far back, moved to challenge two wide into the second turn, took command at mid turn, drew clear in the upper stretch but could not hold the winner. CLASSIC CHATTER raced unhurried from the rail early, angled three wide on the second turn, rallied to the deep stretch then lost her punch. GLO PIRATE stalked the pace from the inside to the second turn, came two wide into the lane but lacked the needed response. ITALIAN WINE set all of the pace from the inside to the second turn and weakened. MISSY KRISSY lagged early then failed to respond.
