Footnotes

WINENPLEASURE was quickly in front to set all of the pace under good rating, took his longest lead in the upper stretch and held driving. BETRAYER settled early just off the rail and within striking distance, advanced four wide into the second turn, dropped over to loom a factor three wide into the lane, finished steadily but could not seriously threaten the winner. MISTY RIDGE lagged to the second turn, circled rivals four wide to the stretch and finished steadily. ARMITAGE stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and faltered. TONIETTA trailed to the second turn, came four wide to the stretch and passed tiring horses. TAMIKA saved ground early, swung out to be three wide on the second turn and failed to rally. MONEY'S NO PROBLEM was unhurried early then was caught behind horses into the stretch, steadied repeatedly and could not reach contention. JACKPOT JAN stalked the pace two wide for six furlongs and gave out. OLIVANI (NZ) saved ground to no avail.
