DAZZLING DIAMONDS was quickly in front to set all of the pace under good rating, responded in the upper stretch and drew clear driving. MICROLADY chased the winner two wide throughout but could make no impact. JEWEL MAGIC (NZ) was permitted to lag early, swung four wide on the second turn but finished in only a mild rally. DARE BUNNY stalked the winner two wide early, eased out to be three wide on the second turn but had no rally. ARCTIC WISH tracked the winner from the rail throughout and lacked a solid finish. COOL DOLL was always outrun.
