BLUE IMP was allowed to settle off the fast early pace, commenced a bid into the second turn, came three wide to the stretch, forged to the front then drifted inward, brushed with LADY CONTINENTAL leaving the furlong grounds then edged away under steady handling. LADY CONTINENTAL settled nicely off the early pace, offered a bid on the second turn, raced up to engage briefly for the lead then was brushed by the winner while being outrun by that one and settled for the place. CAUGHT IN THE DARK (GB) went at a good clip early and pulled clear from her opponents to the half, remained clear to the stretch but weakened through the stretch. FORTUNATE CHANCE was allowed to settle, saved ground on the far turn but lacked the needed closing bid. WOODFORD PRINCESS hesitated, threw her head in the gate and came out well behind the field, trailed to the stretch then finished evenly. AMERICAN JEWEL (NZ) saved ground on both turns but lacked the needed response.
