Footnotes

SASSY WON broke clean and had the best speed, set all the pace to the far turn, responded when asked for more, edged away to mid stretch then held driving. ALYROUND THE FLAG was pinched back at the start then was hard to place into the first turn, finally settled on the backstretch, rallied inside on the second turn then closed steadily through the drive. ARROW ANGEL (NZ) was allowed to settle, offered a bid three wide on the second turn, raced into a contending position into the stretch then could not sustain the needed rally. GO FOR LAUNCH tracked the pace from the rail to the stretch but finished evenly. CATZZENE was in tight while on the rail into the first turn, settled to the half, shifted out and came three wide to the stretch then gradually improved her position in the drive. CHIMNEY FIRE broke slow then was squeezed back early, was wide throughout and did not threaten. JEWEL MAGIC (NZ) pressed the pace to the half, tried to rally outside a rival on the second turn but gave out in the drive. CHECK HER OUT never far back while three wide to the second turn, gave out after six furlongs.
