**Footnotes**

CARESS THE WIND was never too far back while settling on the rail, came through two wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed determinedly to get up in the closing strides. LA PASCALE (GB) was not asked for speed early, commenced her bid once on the second turn, angled three wide and outside the leaders at the quarter pole, challenged in the upper stretch but could not hold the winner. OUR CHARLOTTE tracked the pace from the inside throughout, got through inside TEMAGAMI to gain a short lead into the stretch but could not quite hold. BOURGEOISIE (IRE) was permitted to settle early, advanced from the rail on the second turn to reach serious contention once in the stretch but lacked the needed response. TEMAGAMI set all of the pace from just off the rail and slackened in the drive. THUNDERANDWIND was settled off the pace, raced two wide to the stretch and did not rally. GO FOR LAUNCH was never a factor. SANDPIT'S DELIGHT stalked the pace from the outside for six furlongs and gave out. KISSOUT saved ground to no avail. CAPPED showed little. MI ESQUELA pressed the pace two wide to the stretch and stopped.
