Footnotes

DINO'S PROMISE was bumped by QUINTARA at the start then tracked the pace to the turn, waited for room inside into the stretch, rallied to the lead and inched clear to mid stretch then apparently took a bad step, was not asked for her best late and was collared on the wire. TAVERN ON RUSH stalked the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch then closed with a rush on the leader to get to even terms on the line. TONSILITIS was outsprinted early, raced three wide on the turn, lugged across TAVERN ON RUSH's heels at the quarter pole then recovered and made a good late run. SAN MIGUEL BOY had no speed, was fanned four wide to the stretch and closed steadily in the final furlong. TIALINGA dueled for the early lead, raced three wide to the stretch but tired in the drive. HER EMINENCE was allowed to settle, came three wide to the stretch but could not make an impact late. RIVER STARLET was also settled early, saved ground to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. SABELLA had no speed, was caught four wide on the turn and lacked a rally. MISS AMERICAN PIE had good early speed, responded and inched away to the stretch but tired after five furlongs. GO BELLA GO was always outrun. QUINTARA had brief early speed, came two wide to the stretch but stopped in the drive. A claim of foul by the rider on TONSILITIS against TAVERN ON RUSH was not allowed by the stewards.
