Footnotes

CHIMING (IRE) broke cleanly and tracked the pace well in hand, remained unhurried to the second turn, came off the rail nearing the quarter pole to enter the lane directly behind LINDSAY JEAN, shifted outside that rival approaching the furlong pole to challenge, quickly drew clear and extended her advantage driving. NOCHES DE ROSA (CHI) raced unhurried to the three eighths, angled three wide at mid turn and seemed to lose some of her momentum into the stretch, caught hold again leaving the furlong pole and closed willingly but was never a threat to the winner. LINDSAY JEAN prompted the pace early well in hand, advanced to challenge nearing the quarter pole from the outside, forged to the front once in the stretch, drew clear briefly but had little left for the drive. TURTLE BOW (FR) raced within easy striking distance from between horses to the second turn then failed to respond. NOTTING HILL (BRZ) set all of the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and gave way. SNOWFLAKE (IRE) tracked the pace three wide and outside TURTLE BOW to the second turn then had no rally. MISS PITZ (GB) was never a factor.
