Footnotes

HABAYEB raced under confident handling and lagged well back to the second turn, quickly circled rivals five wide into the lane, continued his bid in the drive to collar the leaders in mid stretch and won driving. JAYBO stalked the pace from well off the rail throughout, responded while between horses leaving the furlong pole and closed gamely. OCEAN PARK raced unhurried early, advanced two then three wide on the second turn and rallied to the leaders from between horses in mid stretch but could not sustain his bid. FELLNER was rank early stalking the pace, settled once in the clear on the backstretch, offered his bid four wide to the stretch, gained command nearing the furlong pole, led to mid stretch then had little left. TYGEMINI stalked the pace from the rail into the stretch and weakened. ATTEMPT set a pressured pace three wide and gave out leaving the furlong pole. TRANSCONTINENTAL steadied early in traffic then settled, raced two wide on the second turn but went evenly in the lane. FORT MASADA lagged early and lacked the needed response. WISENEIMER stalked the pace between horses and slackened two wide on the second turn.
