FLOM'S PROSPECTOR broke in stride then was outsprinted to the turn by EL DORADO SHOOTER, advanced to that rival two wide entering the stretch, quickly drew clear and extended his advantage to the wire driving. FIVE STAR DAY broke in a tangle but reached striking position from the outside in the opening quarter, remained out on the turn, came on for the place but lacked a solid finishing response. EL DORADO SHOOTER broke a step slow then raced up inside to set the pace to the stretch, was headed by the winner once straightened for the drive and lacked further response despite steady urging. AMARILLO PRIDE settled early, came through inside on the turn, the rider dropped his whip at the furlong pole, and lacked the needed rally. GREEK AUTHORITY raced unhurried early, raced three wide and between horses on the turn but failed to respond. LACEY EVITAN was permitted to settle early then had no rally. TODAY A STAR raced wide and was never a serious factor.
