DAZZLING DIAMONDS was quickly in front and set all of the pace under even rating, turned back PILGRIM MISS on the second turn to again draw clear and held gamely in the lane. FULL SCREAM AHEAD was permitted to settle from the rail early, continued inside while racing up behind the winner on the second turn, shifted out for the drive but could make no impact. SIBLA (GB) raced unhurried to the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch but lost her punch. MUSCHI was not asked for speed to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then found her best stride too late. ARROW ANGEL (NZ) saved ground throughout and lacked a closing response. SYERRA BREEZE stalked the pace three wide for six furlong sand slackened. PILGRIM MISS prompted the winner two wide throughout, offered her best bid at the three eighths and had nothing left.
