LOYAL BOUNTY was rated inside to the half, angled four wide while rallying on the second turn, continued to respond in the drive and proved best. STORMING SLEW had no speed then was roused leaving the half, split rivals while making a strong run on the second turn, responded in the drive but could not stall the winner. VIA LATTEA was a pace factor for the outside, pushed to the lead at the half, shook loose into the stretch but tired in the final furlong. TRAIL OF ROSES threw her head and was bumped at the start by TAROMINA, had no early speed, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but finished evenly. GONNA BE A BEAUTE was settled to the half, raced two deep to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. TAROMINA was four wide on the first turn, stalked the leaders to the half, made a brief bid three wide on the far turn but gave out in the lane. SPICY LATINA had speed for a half then stopped suddenly, was eased in the stretch but walked off after crossing the finish line.
