Footnotes

REMEMBER DOROTHY was never too far back while racing in hand early, advanced three wide on the second turn to reach the leaders, challenged leaving the furlong pole, forged to the front in mid stretch and prevailed late. PILGRIM MISS stalked the pace from the outset, took command two wide on the second, dueled in the final furlong but could not hold the winner. SISSI SONG (FR) steadied from the rail into the first turn while mid pack, settled and eased outside, raced three wide on the second turn and finished in a rally. MY RUBY CHARM (NZ) was unhurried early, came four wide on the second turn but lost some of her punch late. SATIN DOLLY lagged early, was fanned four wide on the second turn and lacked a solid closing response. SLEWREEN settled from the inside, tried to rally while two wide into the lane but could not threaten. TEWKIN lagged early, came two wide to the stretch and failed to rally. COOL DOLL was sent to the early lead, led to the second turn and stopped. CAMPAIGN ANDOVER raced wide and was never a serious factor. LUNETTE pressed the pace early, stopped on the second turn and was eased through the stretch but walked off.
