Footnotes

MONA THE SNAKE broke cleanly then took back well off the leaders, commenced her bid from the rail on the turn, remained inside for the drive and closed steadily to get up in the final stride. MADISON DAVIS stalked the dueling leaders from the outset, shifted out into the lane and forged to the front nearing the furlong pole then just failed to last. COMPLETE APPROVAL was never too far back, saved ground on the turn, offered a late bid but could not get up. OFF TO THE OPERA set all of the pace from just off the rail, drifted out in the lane and weakened. IRISH SLEW was forwardly placed early, raced three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. WOODFORD PRINCESS raced unhurried early and failed to reach serious contention. SANTIAGO ROJO steadied at the start to fall behind, then had no rally.
