SAN MIGUEL BOY never far away to the turn, saved ground to the stretch, rallied inside of ANOTHER VARIETY and burst clear to mid stretch then gradually edged away late. ANOTHER VARIETY set the pace to the turn, was off the rail to the stretch, could not stall the winner but dug in late to hold second. QUENCH WENCH prompted the pace to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then finished willingly but missed the place. ECHOES IN HILCO pressed the early pace, fell back while three wide on the turn and was not a factor in the stretch. MOSCOW MATTIE broke a step slow then raced green and was not striding out, fell well behind and did not contend.
