LOVE FEST broke quickest to set all of the pace, drew clear on the turn, extended the advantage on the turn then responded to intermittent urging but generally won as the rider pleased. MINK N' DIAMONDS stalked the winner from the outside early, remained four wide on the turn to move nearest that rival in the upper stretch but could make no impact. GENTLE CHARMER lacked good early speed, saved ground and came on late without being a serious factor. KLEVEN'S ALIBI bumped with BO'S MISS nearing the turn while stalking the winner from just off the rail, raced two wide on the turn but had no rally. AVENUE OF CHARM lacked early speed, raced three wide to the stretch and finished in a mild late rally. BO'S MISS was bumped between horses while tracking the winner into the turn then gradually faded. ROSARY'S FUTURE was never a factor. SALALLY BELLA was slow early, advanced four wide on the turn but came up empty in the lane.
