**Footnotes**

AIRPLANE was permitted to settle in the early going from just off the rail, advanced gradually into the second turn then offered a quick rally while circling rivals five wide to the stretch, challenged nearing the furlong pole from the outside and prevailed in a tight finish. INDEEDYEDO (GB) settled early, rallied quickly four wide and inside the winner on the second turn, drifted in leaving the furlong pole but continued to duel and dropped a tight decision. PRIZED BUY trailed to the second turn, swung widest for the drive but flattened out in the late going. BERTHA'S BIKINI dueled from the inside to the second turn, brief drew clear nearing the stretch but slackened once in the stretch. SASSY CONDUCTION stalked the pace three wide throughout then steadied leaving the furlong pole when squeezed off inside INDEEDYEDO. NO MALO stalked the pace from between horses to the second turn, was blocked nearing the quarter pole to slip back then failed to mount a closing response. CARIBBEANDRIFTWOOD stalked the pace from the rail for six furlongs and faltered. MISTY RIDGE lagged early, tried to rally five wide on the second turn but came up empty. PROSPECTOR'S CROWN dueled two wide to the second turn and stopped then was eased in the stretch but walked off. MARSING could not keep up and was eased through the stretch but walked off. Following a stewards inquiry, INDEEDYEDO was disqualified and placed fifth.
