UNINHIBITED SONG was allowed to settle, came three wide to the stretch but could not threaten the winner. HIGH SILVER tracked the pace two wide to the stretch but finished evenly in the drive. GO ASK DAISY was never far back while outside rivals, raced three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. SPICY CAJUN had no speed, was outrun throughout and checked away from STORMY CHILD in upper stretch. STORMY CHILD was hustled and showed good lick early, seemed to sulk when hit with the whip nearing the turn and gave out in the drive.
