NATURAL TREASURE broke a step slow and raced unhurried for a half, commenced to rally on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch, gathered in the leaders quickly in mid stretch and edged away then seemed to wait on rivals late but held. ENTICE ME chased the pace to the half, went after FREQUENT MEETING and caught that one on the second turn, could not shake loose, was caught herself leaving the furlong pole then was closing the gap late. FREQUENT MEETING sped clear and set all the pace to the second turn, responded when hooked to the stretch, remained a factor to mid stretch but weakened late. STRAWBERRY BANKS was allowed to settle, responded when set down and closed willingly three wide to loom a factor on the second turn then could not sustain that run and tired. SHEIK'S PRINCESS was not a factor. OUR EMERALD was kept wide throughout and showed little.
