**Footnotes**

AT A BOY LUTHER broke alertly then took back off the leaders, advanced two wide into the stretch, shifted out for the drive and closed steadily to get up in the final stride. GEARDOWN stalked the pace outside BILO from the outset, was fanned three wide into the lane but gained command nearing the furlong pole, dueled gamely but could not stall the winner late. BILO tracked the pace from the inside, eased around DIFFERENT CLASS into the lane to take a brief lead at the head of the stretch then was outdueled to the line. TRUCKEE RIVER raced unhurried early, saved ground on the turn but passed only tiring horses. DIFFERENT CLASS set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and slackened. CARTHAGE was never too far back, offered a menacing bid from the outside leaving the three eighths, then stopped suddenly eased out and failed to respond in the lane. INDIO HELIX (ARG) broke a step slow and was never a factor.
