PALACE ROYALE (IRE) pressed the action to the backstretch, raced up to duel for the lead to the stretch, inched away briefly, responded to the challenge of SKY HIGH DANCER and fought back late to edge clear again. SKY HIGH DANCER was unhurried for a half, had to fan out four deep while rallying on the second turn, raced up to loom boldly in upper stretch but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. NAVARRO ROSE set the pace in hand to the backstretch, met the winner's bid at the half, dueled for the advantage to the top of the stretch then weakened in the final eighth. GAMBLINGISAVIRTUE tracked the pace to the half, tried to rally three wide on the far turn but could not come up with the needed late response. BACK SEAT BABE tracked the leaders two wide to the far turn but lacked a late rally. BATES OF COURSE trailed throughout.
