RED FILM (GB) saved ground to the far turn, advanced inside to the stretch, came outside a foe and rallied once straightened for the drive, split horses in deep stretch, took the lead late then just held. MS ERICA was unhurried for a half, rallied three wide on the second turn, engaged the leaders leaving the furlong grounds then finished gamely to just miss. PRISA settled to the backstretch, raced in traffic nearing the half mile pole and was forced to steady, shifted out once in the stretch and closed fastest. SANDY SNEAKERS tracked the leaders three wide, responded to pressure on the far turn, engaged the leaders in upper stretch, battled gamely late and also just missed. CONVEY TO ME set the pace, turned back repeated bids from BEAUX ARTES, dug in through a long drive and only weakened late. BOURGEOISIE (IRE) had no speed, saved ground to the stretch, responded in the drive then was in tight inside of CONVEY TO ME at the sixteenth pole and had to take up late. BEAUX ARTES pulled early and forced the pace to the half, rallied when asked on the second turn, pulled alongside CONVEY TO ME into the stretch, responded to the eighth pole then was crowded between horses late and had to steady hard. WINTER HOUSE had no speed, raced four wide to the stretch and lacked the needed late response. CLASS OF GLASS stalked the leaders to the far turn then could not muster a closing bid. HIGH ON BELIEVEN tracked the leaders to the far turn then gave out. A steward's inquiry into the stretch run resulted in no action.
