JUBILEE was quickest and set the pace to the half, edged clear on the second turn, responded when roused and held driving. BEAUTIFUL DIXIE stalked the pace to the half from the rail, remained inside to the stretch then finished steadily and held the place. IRISH LINEN had no speed, entered the second turn three wide then was forced to circle rivals five wide to the stretch then finished willingly late. ETOILE PETITE was allowed to settle to the half, was asked for speed and was caught four wide on the second turn then finished in a mild rally. FAST ROMANCE checked into the first turn off heels and settled, saved ground to the stretch then lacked the needed response. ARTIST'S COPY was settled to the half, came two wide to the stretch but could not make up the necessary ground. BELL OF THE YEAR tracked the pace from between rivals to the second turn then weakened in the stretch. LADY WOODMAN prompted the pace two wide to the second turn then gave way. CLAIRE SIMOFF was caught four wide on the first turn, settled to the half then lacked a response when asked. AFEELYATED tracked the leader three wide to the half, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but was weakening, checked in upper stretch and gave out.
