NO ETAL rated from the rail for a half, advanced with a good bid on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and wore down SHOW ME GENIUS in the late stages. The latter stalked the pace to the far turn, rallied to take command into the stretch, dug in when roused but failed to hold. LADY LOW saved ground throughout, responded to steady urging into the stretch and closed well in the final furlong. PRIZED BUY settled off the pace early, raced four wide on the final bend and finished with mild interest. MAJESTIC SPLENDOR set the pace to the far turn and withered in the drive. FAIREST HEIRESS was allowed to settle, swung out on the far turn but had nothing to offer in the lane. PURITAN LASS stalked the pace for a half and gave way. LOVE YOU FOREVER ducked inward after the break, was steadied and raced very green throughout. SAKLAD pressed the pace to the far turn and stopped.
