MAYTOWN MISSTREE raced unhurried early, commenced her bid while four wide on the second turn, rallied into the stretch, gained command in mid stretch and edge clear late. GLITTERING AFFAIR was never too far back, advanced into the stretch to loom a bold factor a furlong out, led briefly but could not hold the winner. RIVER BRIDGE (FR) was bumped at the start and took back, remained unhurried to the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and was gaining late. KATHERINE LOUISE was bumped at the start and trailed to the second turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BEST LAID PLANS prompted the pace two wide in hand, forged to the front into the stretch then slackened in the final furlong. CAERLEON QUEEN was rank on the lead to the half mile pole, gave up the advantage after six furlongs and had little left. PRIZED BUY could not keep up and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
