Footnotes

SPINELESSJELLYFISH pressed the pace to the half, bid two wide on the far turn, drew even into the stretch, responded to vigorous handling and got his nose in front nearing the wire but was caught on the line and finished on even terms with NATIVE DESERT. NATIVE DESERT was unhurried for a half, began to pick up the pace on the second turn, was three wide to the stretch, rallied when set down in the drive, drew even then fell back very slightly but made a late surge to get the dead heat. FLYING RUDOLPH pressed the pace from the rail to the half, tried to rally inside nearing the three eighths but lacked room and had to take back slightly, came again and tried to split horses at the top of the stretch but the hole closed, checked again then got through in mid stretch but was outfinished to the wire. TAKIN IT DEEP had no speed, trailed to the stretch and lacked a solid closing response. HALLO BERT set the pace to the backstretch, responded when challenged on the far turn, remained a factor to the quarter pole then weakened through the stretch.
