### Footnotes

ABSOLUTE NECTAR raced up shortly after the break to take command, extended her advantage on the turn and into the stretch, responded to the deep stretch then shortened stride late but held gamely. HAJJI'S HONOR stalked the winner three wide into the lane and was making some late impact. TRISH'S DIAMOND broke quickest then was outrun by the winner to the turn, pressured that rival well into the stretch but lacked the needed response. TREETOP'S GLORY lagged early, saved ground to rally into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. PARISIAN had only brief speed from the extreme outside.
