**Footnotes**

MY RUBY CHARM (NZ) was never too far back, set out after DARLING KRIS on the second turn, forged to the front leaving the furlong pole, drew clear and held SISTER MARY HUGH safe late. SISTER MARY HUGH trailed to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch and finished in a steady rally. DARLING KRIS set all of the pace from the inside to the furlong pole and faded. GAIL'S MELODY lagged early then had no response. PFENNING prompted the pace to the second turn and gave out.
