STREET THEATRE tracked RAMBLIN BOB from the inside under a snug hold, set out after that rival nearing the stretch, eased off the rail and just inside LICARI, continued to close to the final stages then dug in and was up in the last strides. RAMBLIN BOB set all of the pace under fine rating, responded in the lane and just failed to last. CONGRESSIONALHONOR stalked the pace from the inside early, moved off the rail into the second turn, was fanned four wide into the lane and took a bump from LICARI, recovered quickly but lacked the needed response. LICARI prompted the pace two wide from the outset, drifted out a bit leaving the quarter pole, brushed with CONGRESSIONALHONOR and had little left. TACKY lagged early and lacked a solid closing response. NEW COURSE trailed to the stretch then showed a belated response. APOLLO KING settled early and never reached contention. TREVANIAN had no speed in a dull try.
