WOODY HAZE took back at the break and raced under a snug hold, advanced on the backstretch while remaining under restraint, circled rivals three wide to the stretch, forged to the front at the furlong pole and drew clear driving. NEW ADVANTAGE prompted the pace two wide from the outset, challenged for command in the upper stretch but could not stall the winner late. HOW BOUT JOSE tracked the pace while well in hand to the second turn, dropped inside for the drive but lacked the needed response. POPULAR took command from the outside into the first turn to set a pressured pace, dropped inside on the second turn but slackened once in the stretch. PETESKI'S CHARM took back off the leaders from the rail on the backstretch, remained inside on the second turn but did not respond. HOAX (IRE) lagged to the second turn then did not respond in a dull effort.
