**Footnotes**

AIRPLANE settled off the pace and in hand, was sent up three wide on the second turn, collared MANY SWEET REWARDS nearing the furlong pole and pulled clear driving. MANY SWEET REWARDS set all of the pace from the inside but could not match strides with the winner in the stretch. SOLOUGH was void of speed to the second turn, came four wide to the stretch and passed tiring horses. GOLDEN TIP tracked the pace two wide and came up empty. DAZZLING DIAMONDS prompted the pace three wide and gave out. FAIR HOSTAGE failed to reach contention in a dull try. IT'S VICTORIA saved ground and stopped.
