Musafi broke alertly then was permitted to slip back off the dueling leaders, rallied four wide on the turn, got to terms a furlong out and survived a grueling stretch drive. The Barking Shark raced up inside after the break to engage Mr. Doubledown, dueled with that rival the entire way and finished on even terms. Mr. Doubledown dueled two wide throughout, held a slim edge a furlong out and gave way grudgingly. Uncaged Fury, never far back, offered his bid three wide on the turn, weakened slightly in the drive and was in tight in the final stages between rivals. Old Topper lagged well back early and lacked the needed response. Swiss Yodeler broke a step slow then initially rushed up with the leaders but slipped back to stalk from the rail to the stretch and lacked a closing kick. Paying Dues raced five wide throughout and never rallied in a dull try.
