BRITE 'N HAPPY had the best speed and set the pace to the turn, responded into the stretch, inched clear then was under steady pressure to the wire. NUCAYA pressed the pace to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch, could not impact the winner but dug in late to save the place. INDIAN PROSPECT tracked the pace to the turn, came three wide to the stretch, did not threaten the winner then battled for second but missed the nod. POLKA SPOT had no speed, angled over and saved ground to the stretch but came up empty in the drive.
