Footnotes

Emily's Grades stalked the dueling leaders from the rail, was blocked much of the backstretch, split foes once on the 2nd turn to take command, drew clear upper stretch but was all out to finish on even terms with Viva Skeeanno. The latter hopped at the start and was a bit rank early while being taken back, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out once in the drive then rallied determinedly for the deadheat. Anasazi Mud, unhurried early, rallied inside on the second turn and lost much of her punch in the final stages. P J Flyer broke alertly and dropped over to the rail to duel on the lead but had little left once in the stretch. Far North Dancer stalked the pace three wide and weakened. Naturally Nosy lagged early and failed to rally. Miss Brighton, unhurried early, loomed four wide on the second turn and lost her punch. Running River, fractious prior to the start, broke a step slow then raced up to prompt the pace from between horses and stopped.
