Footnotes

HALF FARE was allowed to settle, made a quick run leaving the half mile pole, split horses on the turn, took over at the quarter pole, drew away to mid stretch and was kept to her task to the line. WALL STREET RALLY was four wide to the backstretch, trailed to the second turn, angled in at the three sixteenths then closed steadily for second. SISTER ADIBA dropped over to save ground to the backstretch, was two deep on the second turn but lacked a closing response. TERESA ANN dueled from the rail to the second turn then could not keep up. KIZNITTI tracked the leaders from the rail to the second turn but lacked a rally. BEAUX ARTES stumbled at the start and bumped with EMMA G, raced three wide throughout, had her rider drop his whip at the five sixteenths and was outrun in the drive. EMMA G was bumped at the start, attended the pace to the second turn then gave out.
