OLE CHERYL was hustled early and passed NON SIBI for the lead leaving the five eighths, edged away on the turn then was under steady pressure with the rider deftly switching sticks nearing the furlong pole to win in full stride. NON SIBI broke alertly and was clear leaving the chute, chased after being overtaken by the winner, could not impact that one in the drive but held the place. LUCKY LOUISE had no speed, saved ground on the turn and had a mild late bid. I D QUEEN had no speed, saved ground to the five sixteenths, angled out into the stretch and picked off a couple without threatening. SHE'S ALL FIRED UP tracked the pace to the turn, was three wide and remained a factor to the stretch but had little to offer in the drive. FUHRMIDABLE prompted the leaders to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then weakened in the lane. SOFTWARE was allowed to settle early, gave out on the turn and stopped in the stretch.
