Footnotes

EC LADY (GB) stalked the leaders to the half, bid three wide and drew even into the second turn, inched clear to the stretch then drew clear under steady urging. SATIN DOLLY was forwardly placed off the pacesetter to the half, raced two wide to the stretch, could not stay with the winner but dug in stubbornly to hold second. DANDIONE was allowed to settle to the half, shifted out and was fanned four wide on the far turn, loomed a factor into the stretch then could not sustain a rally. WARP raced unhurried to the half, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but was tiring in the final furlong. VALOROSA had no speed for a half, circled four wide on the second turn to close the gap to the stretch but had little left for the drive. SHE ROCKS (IRE) saved ground but was not a factor. GLO PIRATE set a pressured pace to the half but stopped on the second turn.
